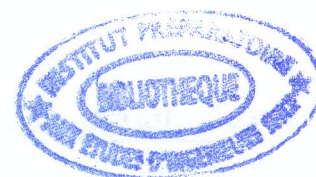

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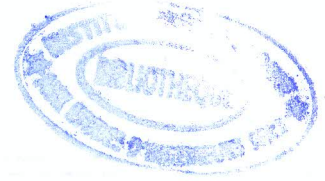


Task Two: Put the bracketed words in the right tense and /or form (3.5 pts):
