Since August 2017, over 650,000 Rohingya have fled their homes in Myanmar to seek (1) **(save)** in neighbouring Bangladesh. (2) **(Drive)** from their communities by Myanmar's armed forces who have burned villages, raped and (3) **(kill)** infants after ripping them from their mothers' arms, most of the refugees (4) **(settle)** in camps in the Bangladeshi city of Cox's Bazar. The overcrowded living conditions present many risks, (5) **(include)** human trafficking. The Rohingya are a majority Muslim ethnic groups that reside prior to their expulsion (6) **(primary)** in Myanmar. They are effectively stateless, unable (7) **(receive)** citizenship in their home country and unwanted in Bangladesh. In addition to being a serious abuse of human rights and dignity, this lack of citizenship reduces economic opportunity, increases isolation and (8) **(heighten)** the risk of human trafficking. Reports suggest that trafficking is rampant in the refugee camps with men, women and children exploited for (9) **(commerce)** sex and forced and bonded labor. The risk of trafficking is even higher for children, particularly (10) **(that)** without parents.
